

What Is Project 2025? Inside the Far-Right Plan Threatening Everything from the Word 'Gender' to Public Education

Trump's allies started Project 2025 as a blueprint for marrying church and state at the highest levels of government if he's elected. The 2025 Presidential Transition Project, more commonly known as Project 2025, released a 900 page manifesto last year titled "Mandate for Leadership: The Conservative Promise." The policy guidebook — compiled by the conservative think tank Heritage Foundation in partnership with more than 100 other conservative organizations — lays out a far-right, Christian nationalist vision for America that would corrode the separation of church and state, replace nonpartisan government employees with Trump loyalists and bolster the president's authority over independent agencies. Below are some of the Project's major tenets.

- Christian nationalism - marrying Church and State
- Firing disloyal government personnel
- Rolling back reproductive rights, abortion access, contraception
- Eliminating LGBTQ+ protections
- Banning broadly defined pornography
- Politicizing the Justice Department and FBI
- New immigration and border control practices
- Education vouchers not public schools, return of student loans
- Restricting school curriculum and axing diversity & inclusion
- Rejecting climate change action completely
